#### Call for Point 2.12 Contributions!

- ➤ Several responses have reached us with regard to contributions from various National Radiofrequency Agencies in favour of maintaining this point in the final WRC'07 agenda as well as proposals to reformulate the text so that frequency needs are met more efficiently.
- ➤ We think that this is the occasion on which to better delineate the actual field of application of "aeronautical telemetry". We therefore suggest that members draft a brief memo outlining what they understand by the strict definition of RR (Radio Regulations) of ITU-R with regard to their requirements. All replies will be published in NL#16.
